## Process Redesign: Oct 16-19, 2017

## Power of Process: Oct 30 – Nov 1, 2017

A Hammer Certification class for process engineers and teams building awareness, insight and engagement in their organizations. Participants will learn to:

- Recognize functional silos and how they undermine performance
- Explain process as the antidote to fragmentation
- Develop strategies for increasing process awareness, insight and engagement
- Sustain performance improvements through dashboards and visual management

### **Leading Transformation**: Oct 30 – Nov 1, 2017

Hammer Certification for process engineers and teams developing enterprise capabilities to support process management and sustain process performance. Participants will learn to:

- Establish a rationale for business transformation and conduct a readiness audit
- Address process success factors ownership, performers, IT systems and measures
- Address enterprise success factors leadership, governance, expertise and culture
- Lead change in the context of a business transformation

### Implementation and Execution: Nov 2-3, 2017

Advanced Certification for process engineers and teams implementing changes in people, process and technology across organizational boundaries. Participants will learn to:

- Define business and system changes and their impacts on stakeholders
- Develop implementation strategies, roadmaps and transition plans
- Determine milestones, dependencies, risks and mitigation strategies
- Accelerate adoption through oversight, decision rights, systems and measures
